Complaint

Vehicle Sale Without a Valid Georgia Vehicle Emissions Inspection

Dear Georgia Motorist:

Following please find the Used Vehicle Sale Complaint Form regarding a vehicle allegedly sold in Georgia without a current, valid passing emissions inspection on file (dated within 12 months of the purchase date). To view a summary of your vehicle's most recent Georgia Emissions Inspection reports (VIRs), visit the Georgia's Clean Air Force (GCAF website (www.cleanairforce.com), link to the Motorists tab and choose "View Your Most Recent Test Results" under "Quick Links."

In order for this complaint to be initiated and properly investigated, you must complete the Used Vehicle Sale Complaint Form and provide at a minimum, the following information:

- Completed affidavit detailing events of sale
- Copy of the bill of sale*
- Copy of title* (front and back), if available (title application, if not)
- Copy of repair receipts and/or diagnostic tests (if any)
- Copy of any additional paperwork provided at time of sale

The completed Used Vehicle Sale Complaint Form and supporting documentation can be submitted via e-mail to info@cleanairforce.com, or drop it off at one of the GCAF Customer Service Centers. For a complete listing of GCAF Customer Service Centers, click here.

*The bill of sale or title must include the seller's name and address, the buyer's name and address, and the sale date. If you recently moved to Georgia, your address on the bill of sale or title must be an address from within the 13 covered counties that require emissions testing in order for you to qualify for a used vehicle sale violation.

Once this information is received, an investigation will be initiated to determine if there has been a violation of O.C.G. A. 12-9-54. GCAF personnel will conduct the investigation within five business days and notify you via mail or email.

Please note that GCAF does not have the authority to work on your behalf or negotiate vehicle buyback or repair settlements between you and the seller. Outreach, education and enforcement actions by GCAF and the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) are completely separate from any actions you may take against the seller.

Possible violation of O.C.G.A. 12-9-54. Sale of a Vehicle without Emissions Inspection

Complaints on vehicle sales without emissions certificates <u>require</u> an affidavit detailing the events of the sale, copies of the bill of sale and other paperwork received during the purchase of the vehicle. Georgia's Clean Air Force (GCAF) personnel will notify you via mail once the investigation is complete.

*You must supply an affidavit (either a handwritten or typed document to explain the reason for your complaint) and either a bill of sale or title to show your sale date in order for your complaint to be processed. We cannot process complaints without this documentation. The other requested documents are not required, but are helpful with the investigation.
