THREE TIPS TO PREPARE FOR YOUR VEHICLE'S EMISSIONS INSPECTION

& Gain Better Fuel Efficiency

Georgia's Clean Air Force provides a wealth of information for motorists to help them prepare their vehicles for the emissions testing process. Many of the recommendations for inspection preparation offer another advantage for Georgia drivers facing high gas prices: better fuel efficiency and improved overall vehicle performance.



Keep the sealing surfaces of your fuel cap clean and in good condition. A dirty or ill-fitting gas cap allows fuel to evaporate and harmful pollutants to escape into the air.



Pay attention to the "Check Engine" light. Don't delay taking your vehicle to the service station when the "Check Engine" light comes on. A failed sensor or other problem can significantly impact both fuel economy and emissions testing.



Ensure that tires are properly inflated. According to the US Department of Energy, gas mileage can be improved by 0.6% on average, and up to 3% in some cases, by keeping tires inflated to the proper pressure.
